Incentives and Regulations

Law No. 24(November 23rd, 1992) that creates incentives and regulates reforestation activities in Panama

- Revenue tax exemption
- 100 % return on tax-related expenses
- Property tax exemptions
- Import tax exemption for machinery, equipment and agrochemicals
- Creates Forestry Investment Visa
